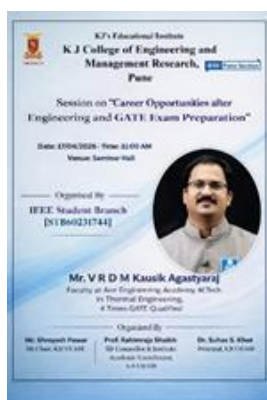
Session on "Career Opportunities after Engineering and GATE Exam Preparation".
