Priyanka first introduced the campaign‘Bas Ab Bahut Ho Gaya - Enough is Enough!’ This campaign aims to win the fight against gender-based violence, especially violence against women. As part of this campaign a series of films will be released over a period of a year highlighting different perspectives on gender based violence. After that series of videos have been released on projector highlighting various aspects of gender issues. Then after Ms. Soniya Yadav and Ms. Khushbu Saroj sung very beautiful song ‘Rupaiya’ from Satyamev Jayate show.

First Speaker was Saket Mani sir. Considered to be a staunch feminist; Saket Mani serves as the Youth Planet 50/50 Champion for gender equality to support UN Women’s work through the office of the United Nations Assistant Secretary General and Deputy Director of the UN Women. He mobilised more than 150,000 people to pledge and commit for the ‘HeForShe’ campaign, the UN Women's Solidarity Movement for Gender Equality. He organized and conceptualised the first series of public Youth Dialogues on Gender Equality with UN Assistant Secretary-General in Chennai and Delhi. His work on Gender Equality especially on engaging men & boys has positioned India as the leading country globally in the HeForShe movement as recognized by UN Women. Recognizing his work and achievement, UN Women made a short film on his advocacy in India which was showcased at the high level HeForShe 2nd Anniversary Celebration attended by prominent Heads of Governments and celebrities during the 71st UN General Assembly.

Second Speaker was Dr Mrs Rani D Khedikar, who the first ever researched on the children of Sex Workers, their plight and deprivation from basic rights as humans. She has been associated with social organisations such as PANATI who work for the welfare of the children of prostitutes and try to give them a better life free from the stigma and poverty. She has also worked as a coordinator for WHO related projects for child health and welfare. She has also served as principal for Sunflower Kids School, Pune. Currently she is working as a Mumbai vibhag sanghatak saad manuskichi.

Third guest was Amit Jain sir who has spent his life in helping the underprivileged and the down trodden with support and resources either through his own organisation or others. Mr. Amit Jain, co-founder and president of Mitti Ke Rang, an organisation that has helped more than 50,000 women and children. A philanthropist and a vocal advocate of the rights of women and children, he is a Global Youth Ambassador for the United Nations and also a part of the World Economic Forum. Not only this, he is the Editor-in-Chief of The Proton and firmly believes that empowering women contribute to the health and productivity of families and communities.

The Program was very interesting. Rani Madam discussed very important points on children of prostitutes, How to treat these children's. How common people or students can help to them. How we can contribute to our nation and lots more things. Saket sir discussed very nicely about how we start for Gender equality from our home and then to outside.he discussed this issue with some videos.Amit sir Discussed about very different topic of widows; he noted that we have to treat these women's respectively. And we have to give all rights to them .Respected Anand Thakar Sir also gave very energetic speech on to change our psychology to treat all gender equally.
